

# Well Integrity 2011

3rd industry workshop for NCS  
Thursday May 26th 2011

Radisson Blu Atlantic Hotel - Stavanger

## **Background**

During the spring of 2006 the PSA (Petroleum safety Authority) performed a well integrity audit/survey towards seven (7) operating Companies on the NCS.

Every fifth well showed uncertainty and weaknesses in well integrity.

A report published in June 2006 following the survey concluded on several areas for Improvements and challenged the operators to expand on the survey.

## **Industry action**

As a result of the survey OLF's Resource Group Drilling, Drilling Managers Forum (DMF) took initiative for a workshop planned during the winter 2006 – 2007.

The workshop was held March 5th – 6th 2007 with 45 Participants.

## **Objectives**

The objective was to get the industry to work together to identify common goals, processes, focus areas and possible co-operation projects.

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### **Establishing Well Integrity Forum (WIF).**

The well Integrity Forum (WIF) was established in June 2007 as a subgroup of OLF's Drilling Managers Forum (DMF). The resource groups and networks report to OLF's Operations Committee.

WIF represents the following field operators with production wells in Norway:

BP, ConocoPhillips, Eni Norge, ExxonMobil, Marathon, Nexen, Norske Shell, Statoil, Talisman and Total.

WIF members meet monthly and task forces have been established to work on defined tasks.

A second workshop was arranged in May 2009 in Stavanger.

## **WIF's Mandate**

The mandate is to discuss regulatory requirements and guidelines, share experiences, identify common goals and cooperate to solve common challenges within Well Integrity during the wells lifecycle (main focus on Operating phase).
